

Priorities of Jesus



The Discovery Bible study method is a helpful way to explore Scripture together:

- Pray and ask the Lord to give you clarity over the Scripture you are reading.
- Read the passage. Have someone re-tell the story in their own words
- Discuss what these verses tell us about God. Praise Him for these attributes.
- Re-read passage. Discuss what these verses reveal about humanity.
- As you ponder these truths, how is God inviting you to respond? What one thing can you do this week?
- Who could you share this story with?

In this six-week study of Mark we are walking with Jesus to explore His priorities. We will see how He interacted with the people around Him. We will see where He focused His time and energy. We will see what meant the most to Him.

As you journey with Jesus, may your heart beat for the same things His did, may you see Him and yourself in new light and may you look more like Him than when you began.

The most important part of this study is the application question- hold one another accountable and maybe even do these things together.
