5.	How do 11:44–45 relate to these commands?
6.	How does 12:7 help to explain the uncleanness of birth? Look at chapter 15 in connection with chapter 12.
7.	Why do spreading skin diseases make a person unclean (13:1-46)?
8.	Why does mold render something unclean (13:47–59)?

- 9. Notice the complexity of the rituals to make atonement for skin diseases and mold. Why is this, do you think?
- 10. Look at 15:31 and think about it in relation to the event that started this whole series (10:1-7).
- 11. According to Jesus it is what comes out of our mouths from our hearts that make us unclean (Matt 15:10–11). How does that statement relate to what appears here in chapters 11–15? Why does God make so much of this?
